1-0 . Name : The name of the centre shall be social Aids improvement and mass action (SAIMA) , (Here in referred to as 'Society (SAIMA)).

1.2 Establishment : SAIMA is established from 23.11.99.

2-0 . Location : The office of the society for the present at Kodala - 761032 (Ganjam) .

Provided that the said office may be moved to such some other suitable place as the Board of the Management of the SAIMA shall decide fromtime to time.

3-0 . Jurisdiction : The scope of activities of the SAIMA shall extend over theMunicipal/NAC/Panchayat limits of Chatrapur Sub-Division ~~in~~ /in the district of Ganjam.

4-0 Function : The SAIMA has been formed to function as a non-profitable, charitable regional , non-political body as stated in detail in the Bye-laws of the SAIMA.

To establish educational institution from pre-primary standard to Degree standard with high class Research facilities as per the syllabus of the State and Central Govt.

5-2.4

To provide for the students as well as the community as a whole, the education based on human values with emphasis on moral and spiritual values for the development of the human excellence and personality and to achieve better performance in academic career and character building.

5-2.5

To establish vocational institutes and health Centres, vocational guidance centres in rural area for upliftment of the community. Priority should be given to women, marginal farmer, landless labourer handicapped, small farmer, educated un-employees, poor and neglected community etc. ~~To provide~~

5-2.6

To provide popularisation of science programme and advancement of science and technology ^{Communication} in rural and urban slums ^{for promotion} of scientific attitude/temper.

5-2.7

Promotion of education, science, culture, eradication of illiteracy and health hazards through different Training Camps, workshops exhibitions, meetings, seminars, symposia, competition and coaching programmes, etc.

5-2.8

Facilitate research programmes and publish journals, articles, periodicals, etc. Priority should be given to restore old heritage, culture and history and science

5-2.9

To promote mobile library facility, field strips.

5-2.10

Steps shall be taken for national integration and international understanding.

5-2.11

Establish orphan centres and institutes for Physical Handicapped ~~para~~ children and helpless women as well as mentally Retards.

5-2.12

To celebrate functions on the memories of the eminent poets, writers, scientists and national leaders.





To inspire young writers, poets, individuals involved in the field of education, science, literature, culture and heritage.

5-2.14

To provide Indoor & outdoor game facilities.

5-2.15

To call for various competitions and award prizes.

5-2.16

To celebrate functions to honour various prominent persons whose contribution is in the field of science, education, literature, history and culture.

5-2.17

To organise different camps for ladies, gents and especially for neglected children.

5-2.18

Establish museum with rare collection.

5-2.19

Arrange Agricultural Training Programmes or establish Agricultural institutes for promotion of Agricultural Technology and Agricultural Science in the rural field.

5-2.20

Adequate steps shall be taken for plantation, environment pollution, preservation of ~~walshurux~~ forest, mal-nutrition, health preservation, drug addiction, immunisation, awareness against H.I.V., Promotion of Adventure etc.

5-2.21

To take measures in ~~times~~ ^{times} of natural and national calamities for peaceful co-existence and to help the affected populace and to promote low cost dwellings and utilisation of other amenities.

To take adequate steps for providing legal aid, & to spread awareness of Consumer rights among the people.
